Program Fee Schedule Breakdown Available

Newbridge Academy Advancement Fund (NAAF)

All new and returning students in Grades Primary through to Twelve incur an additional \$1,500 fee per student. This is to help provide brand new state-of-the art facilities designed for academic and athletic excellence. This is necessary to bridge the financial gap between our existing operation and the new operation including the new facility. This will be re-evaluated every year to determine the effectiveness of the fund. \$1,000 enrolment deposits will go toward this fee and the remaining \$500 is due August 1st.

Enrolment Bond

As part of enrolment at Newbridge Academy each student is required to pay an Enrolment Bond. This Enrolment Bond is a non-interest bearing, one-time payment for enrollment into Newbridge Academy. The Enrolment Bond for students entering Grades Primary through to Twelve is \$2,500.

Financial Assistance

A bursary program is available. Families in financial need must to apply for an independent assessment through Apple Financial. Apple Financial Services have been providing bursary and financial assistance analysis to private schools in Canada since 1993. Apple Financial provides Newbridge Academy with an analysis on what the family can afford. As Newbridge Academy funds the bursaries directly, we reserve the right for final say in the bursary amount.
